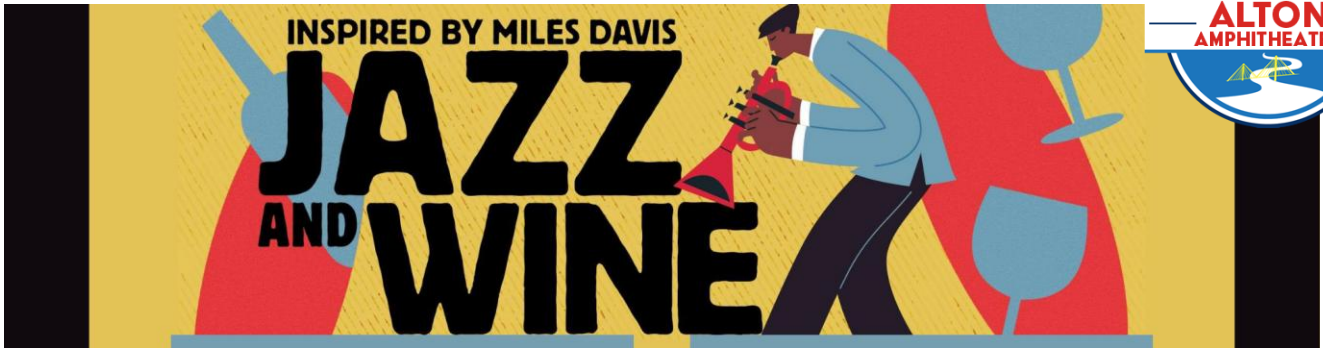

Arrival + Entry

Choose the directions that match your ticket or parking purchase.

VIP PARKING

If you purchased VIP parking, enter on the Argosy Casino side and proceed to the parking lot in front of the splash pad. A security guard will direct you to your space.

GENERAL PARKING

General parking is available in the Argosy Casino and Henry Street parking lots.

ENTRANCES

Tickets will be scanned at both the Riverfront Park (Splashpad side) and Riverfront Drive entrances (indicated with yellow circles on the diagram below). If you need the Box Office, use the Riverfront Drive entrance.

BOX OFFICE

The Box Office opens at 5:00 PM on the day of the show. Walk-up tickets may be purchased at the venue starting at 5:00 PM.

SECURITY

All bags are subject to inspection. Each guest may bring one unopened bottle of water.



Finding Your Seat

Ushers will be seating reserved ticket-holders.

RESERVED 2 AND 4-TOP TABLES

Tables are located on the stage and will be seated first come, first served within the section shown on your ticket. Arriving early will give you the most seating options.

Front-row table guests will be escorted to an available front-row table. General admission table guests will be guided to an available table beginning in the second row. Your ticket gives you access to a designated table section, not a specific table number. Your ticket indicates whether you purchased at two-top or four-top table.

Sponsor tables will be marked reserved.

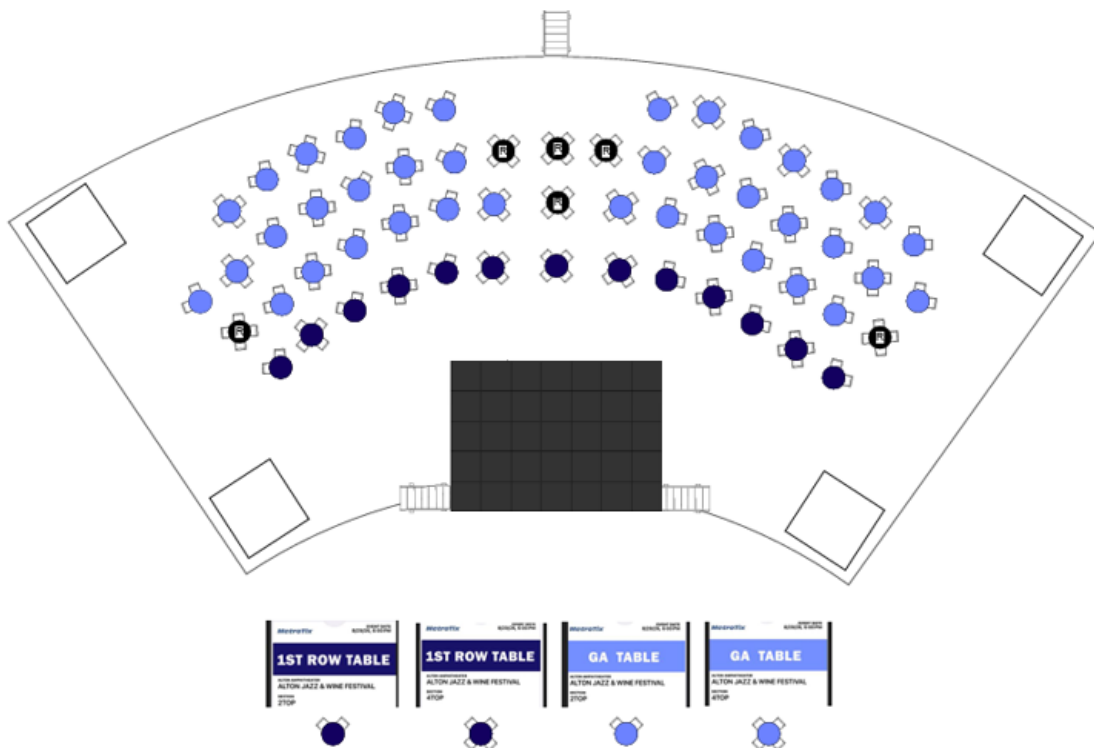
RESERVED LAWN SEATING

White folding chairs will be available in the front row of the lawn. Your ticket gives you reserved access to a seat, not a specific seat number. Arriving early will give you the most seating options.

An usher will guide you to an open seat in that section. We encourage groups who want to sit together to arrive at the same time. Saving seats for others may not be guaranteed.

GENERAL ADMISSION LAWN

Choose your spot on the lawn and bring one lawn chair per ticket holder or a blanket. Pop-up tents are not permitted. Children age 5 and younger are admitted free.

PRE-ORDERS + CHARCUTERIE

Pick up pre-ordered wine bottles and charcuterie at the designated pickup point under the beverage tent. Brown Bag Bistro charcuterie boxes will also be available there for \$25, while supplies last.

Wine will be available by the glass or bottle. Beer, Carbliss and other assorted beverages will also be available for purchase.

Featured Musicians

Three performances carry Miles Davis’ spirit of experimentation into the evening.

KASIMU TAYLOR’S 100 MILES TRIBUTE

Kasimu Taylor opens the evening with soulful trumpet storytelling and a blend of jazz, community spirit and musical freedom.

PLAYADORS

The St. Louis ensemble brings 1970s jazz-funk fusion to the stage through heavy grooves, intricate melodies, soulful vocals, original music and reimagined classics.

BUTCHER BROWN

The Richmond, Virginia-based group blends jazz with hip-hop, funk, soul, rock and psychedelic influences. They blend jazz with hip-hop, funk, soul, rock, and psychedelic influences, creating what they call “solar music”—inspired by everything under the sun. Their new album, A Supreme Blue, reimagines music from Miles Davis’ Kind of Blue alongside John Coltrane’s A Love Supreme.

Featured Art

A large-scale tribute created from donated trumpets.

“A Thousand Echoes of Kool,” by Alton-based artist Michael Snider of Kooliverse, measures 40 feet long, 15 feet tall and 8 feet wide. Once completed, the sculpture will feature 1,000 donated trumpets as a living celebration of Miles Davis’ legacy.

ABOUT MICHAEL SNIDER OF KOOLIVERSE

Michael Snider is an Alton-based artist whose experiential artwork is ever present in our public spaces. The consummate creator, Michael is highly skilled in fabricating, woodworking, resin pouring, illuminating, upcycling, custom framing and so much more. While the Kooliverse is infinitely-expanding, its epicenter is rooted in Downtown Alton. You can catch his jaw-dropping creations exhibited at many local establishments and displayed at community events.
